


Considerations About Time

Everything Has Its Time and Season

Dear Friends and Supporters—a belated Happy New Year,

Here are a few New Year's thoughts to ponder. When Solomon became King of Israel following his father David, God granted him whatever he desired. Solomon asked for wisdom to rule over the people well. Because of his selflessness, God blessed him with both riches and wisdom. He parsed times and seasons in over two dozen ways, saying, "To everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven," adding that "God has made everything beautiful in its time (Ecclesiastes 3:1-11).

Solomon also stated that everything has its time and season. Centuries later, the Apostle Paul exhorted the Ephesian believers to walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise. As believers, we too need to walk circumspectly, skirting around the things of this world that are not pleasing to the Lord, but using our lives wisely, with eternal values in view (Ephesians 5:15).

Every Time Is Right to Spread the Gospel

Considering present day times and seasons, it's evident that the moment of Christ's return for His Saints is growing ever nearer. Jesus (relating to Himself) spoke to his disciples of a certain nobleman who went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom and then to return. Before leaving, the nobleman called his servants together and gave each one ten Minas (*four months' wages*). The nobleman then instructed them to "Occupy (do business) until I come" (Luke 19:13).

What does Christ's command to "occupy" refer to now, in 2026? World missions Christians believe it refers to the same thing now as it did when Jesus first gave the prime directive of: "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15).

Revelation 5:9 speaks about *some* from every kindred, tongue, people, and nation being present at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb. Yet there are still unreached people groups that need to hear the Good News of salvation by Grace through Faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. They too need to have an opportunity to hear, believe and be saved. That's what Cheryl and I gave our lives to see happen. When we meet the Lord *face-to-face*, I would like to hear Him say "Well done, thou good and faithful servant...enter into the joy of thy lord" (Matthew 25:21).

I believe that you'd like to hear Him say the same to you as well. May it be so as we labor together to that end.
