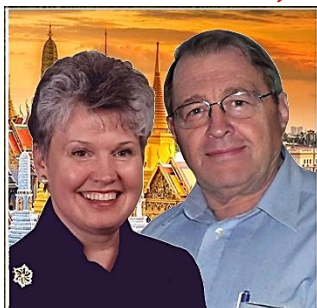



One who comes to mind is Mr. Decha, a Thai Immigration Officer who found forgiveness for his troubled sin-laden soul through Jesus' love. I met Officer Decha when he was taking his noonday break. We struck up a light conversation during which he commented on my Thai speaking ability. When I explained that I was a missionary he blurted out, *"You are? I've read about Jesus. Can you tell me more?"* I assured him that I could. We met over lunch the following day. That's when Decha became a new-found Child of God!

When Officer Decha arrived, he immediately poured out his heart, acknowledging all the wicked things he had done as a corrupt policeman. *"What can I do?"* he pleaded. I said *"Tell God all you just told me and ask Him for mercy,"* which he did as I listened. I assured Decha that God promised He would forgive him, come into his life as his Lord and Savior, and give him the gift of *Eternal life*." Decha is now a born-again Christian living for Christ. He is also a member of the Thai Christian Police Association. We praise God that the Gospel is for whosoever will come in faith believing, not just a preselect few (John 3:15-16; Ephesians 2:8-9, Revelation 22:17).

Please pray for my complete healing from the bleeding that occurred in my brain when I tripped and fell. Otherwise, I won't be able to return to Thailand and complete the new, spoken Thai translation. My recent CT scan showed that the blood spot in my brain has decreased. The hospital's Neurological Research Center's doctors assured me all would eventually return to normal. Finally, I praise my dear wife Cheryl, who has been managing the myriads of meds I have been taking. *"I praise thee, God; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made"* (Psalms 139:14).
